Establish Service Tracks:

- ✓ Employment (Retail, Health Care, Customer Service, Self-Employment, etc.)
- ✓ Military/Government (Armed Forces, DoD, USPS, State, County, etc.)
- ✓ Adult Education/College (GED, Math, ESL, etc.)
- ✓ Training (Truck Driving, Computer Systems Admin, CNA, etc.)
 - Incumbent Worker Training to assist workers with the skills necessary to retain employment or avert layoffs.
 - Transitional Jobs subsidized work experience for individuals with multiple barriers to employment.
 - On-the-job Training paid training by an employer that is reimbursed at 50% of the wages.
- Concentrate on meeting minimum job requirements.

90 - Day Plan

90-Day Plan vs. 1-Year Plan:

- S <u>Specific</u> to accomplish a specific objective (Attend two work readiness workshops)
- M <u>Measurable</u> to measure the outcome (Complete 5 job search assignments)
- A <u>Attainable</u> to set expectations within reach (Only apply for qualified positions)
- R Relevant to establish meaningful outcomes (Employment opportunities of their choice)
- T <u>Time-based</u> to have beginning and end date (start and end date)

- Establish plan for those not in group activities.
- ✓ Activities: job search, resumes, applications, etc.
- ✓ Document as "group" activities

What about those not in groups?

- ✓ Aggressive plan to re-engage. (outside the box)
- ✓ Partner services, reduce unwanted exits, WIFM.


